DESCRIPTION OF WORK: This work involves identifying individuals and families in need of services that can be provided by the agency through the Medicaid Community Alternatives Program for Disabled Adults (CAP-DA), Home and Community Care Block Grant program and State In-Home program. The worker is responsible for interviewing, assessing and arranging for the delivery of certain in-home services that enable elderly and disabled individuals to remain in their own homes and avoid or delay placements in nursing homes. The worker serves as a case manager for approximately 35-45 elderly and disabled individuals who are at risk of long-term placement and who desire to receive services in their homes. As a case manager, this worker coordinates, locates, directs, monitors and assists in determining eligibility for social, medical, financial and other services to meet the needs of elderly and disabled individuals and other duties as assigned.

Minimum Training and Experiment Requirements: Bachelor's degree in social work from an accredited school of social work; Bachelor's degree in a human services field from an accredited college or university and one year directly related experience; Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university and two years directly related experience.

*Directly related experience is defined as human services experience in the areas of case management, assessment and referral, supportive counseling, intervention, psycho-social therapy and treatment planning. Degrees must be received from appropriately accredited institutions.

Will consider the following minimum education and experience as a work-against with Starting Salary \$27,173. Four-year degree from an accredited university or college in a human service field. **Only those applicants meeting the specific requirements above will be considered for an interview.
