DESCRIPTION OF WORK: The primary purpose of this position is to determine the eligibility of new applicants and current recipients seeking assistance through the provisions of the Work First Cash Assistance Program; provide case management services to Work First Family Assistance (WFFA) Program recipients who participate in the WFFA Employment Services Program to enable them to become self-sufficient and self-supporting. Some representative duties and responsibilities include: develop work sites to provide WFFA recipients with work experience; provide or arrange counseling, support and motivation; case management which includes assessing education status, employability and monitoring of performance; serve as a liaison with community colleges, work sites, Employment Security Commission and other community agencies; This position also provides general intake services to families in crisis, accurately assessing their needs and arranging for access to or providing appropriate services to alleviate the crisis and strengthen the family.

Minimum Training and Experiment Requirements: Bachelor's degree in social work from an accredited school of social work; Bachelor's degree in a human services field from an accredited college or university and one year directly related experience; Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university and two years directly related experience; an equivalent of education and experience.

*Directly related experience is defined as human services experience in the areas of case management, assessment and referral, supportive counseling, intervention, psycho-social therapy and treatment planning.

**Will consider the following minimum education and experience as a work-against with Starting Salary \$27,173. Bachelor's degree from an accredited university or college in a human service field; Bachelor's degree from an accredited college/university and one year of directly-related experience.
