WASHINGTON COUNTY - WATER TREATMENT PLANT SUPERVISOR

Washington County seeks qualified applicants for the position listed above, to perform technical and skilled manual labor to oversee the operation and maintenance of the county water treatment plant.

Essential duties include: Overseeing chemical treatment and testing processes; performing preventative plant maintenance; understanding, monitoring, and ensuring compliance with local, state, and federal rules and regulations; communicating with officials and the public about water supply issues; supervising plant personnel; managing plant equipment, contracts, and budgets.

Minimum qualifications include: High school diploma or equivalency required. Additional related education or training is preferred. Experience working in a water treatment plant and/or distribution environment (particularly in a supervisory/management capacity) is preferred. B-Well Certification, Process Distribution and Process Chemistry 1 required (Applicants with C-Well Certification may be considered contingent upon obtaining a B-Well Certification within the first year of employment).

Other: Candidates must have a valid NC Driver's License and the ability to use and operate computers, and all departmental vehicles and equipment proficiently. A drug test, skills aptitude test, and background investigation will be required pre-employment.
