

TELECOMMUNICATOR

Washington County Sheriff Office is recruiting for a part-time telecommunicator position in its 911 Center. Applicant must be able to multitask, speak clearly and remain calm and courteous during emergencies. Applicant must be able to type a minimum of 30wpm and operate two-way radio equipment. Applicant will be able to work nights, weekends and holidays. Applicant must possess a high school diploma or GED, be at least 18 years of age and pass a criminal background. Upon being hired the applicant will be required to complete the 47 hour Telecommunicator Certification Course and pass the State Exam. The applicant will also be required to complete Emergency Medical Dispatch Certification, DCI certification and pass both exams.
