

May 9, 2011

The Washington County Board of Commissioners met in a recessed session on Monday, May 9, 2011 at 11:00 AM in the Commissioners Room, 116 Adams Street, Plymouth, NC. Commissioners Alexander, Collins, Johnson, Manning and McCray were present. Also present was David L. Peoples, County Manager, Senator Stan White and Representative Tim Spear.

Chair Johnson called the May 9, 2011 meeting to order.

Commissioner Johnson spoke to Senator White and Representative Spear about the need for ensuring there will be adequate mental health funding and the need to protect the County jail system. Discussion ensued.

Commissioner Alexander spoke to Senator White and Representative Spear about reinstating ADM and lottery funds for school construction and supporting conservation of working lands and farmland preservation. Discussion ensued.

Commissioner Collins spoke to Senator White and Representative Spear about preserving the existing local revenue base and opposing the shift of State transportation responsibilities to Counties. Discussion ensued.

Commissioner McCray spoke to Senator White and Representative Spear about enhancing river basin monitoring. Discussion ensued.

Mr. Peoples spoke to Senator White and Representative Spear about streamlining rule-making. Discussion ensued.

Mr. Peoples also showed a PowerPoint presentation highlighting the recent economic developments in Washington County.

With there being no further business to discuss, Commissioner McCray made a motion to recess the meeting. Commissioner Manning seconded, motion carried unanimously.
