

# **RESOLUTION 2024-031**

#### LASSITER PROPERTY ACQUISITION

**WHEREAS**, North Carolina General Statute §153A-158 authorizes counties to acquire property for County purposes; and

WHEREAS, Washington County has been studying certain alternative property locations to determine which might be the most feasible location to construct a new emergency management, training, and operations center (EMTOC); and

**WHEREAS**, Randy C. Lassiter & Lynn U. Lassiter own a certain parcel of real property which is more particularly described in a deed thereto recorded in Book 525, Page 541, of the Washington County Register of Deeds Office; and also identified herein for informational purposes as being that property listed with the county tax records as Parcel: 6777.06-47-8856; and

**WHEREAS**, Washinton County is interested in purchasing said parcel of property as it is generally depicted on the attached Survey for Washington County by Hood Richardson, P.A. dated 8/15/24 for use in connection with the purpose described hereinabove; and

WHEREAS, this Board previously authorized staff to enter into an Agreement for Purchase and Sale of Land with the owners of said parcel to permit the County a period of time to conduct certain due diligence review of said property prior to making a final decision to purchase it or not for the requested consideration of ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$125,000); and

WHEREAS, after entering into said agreement, staff were subsequently required to negotiate two separate extensions of the original due diligence period for certain additional consideration, all of which is to be credited toward the purchase price for the County at closing, with the exception of an additional non-refundable ONE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED ELEVEN DOLLARS & TWENTY CENTS (\$1,411.20); and

**WHEREAS**, based on its due diligence review of alternative site locations, staff recommends moving forward with the purchase of the property described hereinabove; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board is of the opinion that it is in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the County to fully authorize the acquisition of the property described hereinabove for the aforesaid purpose of using it to construct a new emergency management, training, and operations center in Washington County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners for the County of Washington as follows:

- 1. That the County Manager are hereby authorized to take any and all actions necessary to obtain the property upon the terms and conditions set forth herein and in the aforesaid Agreement for Purchase and Sale of Land, as extended.
- 2. That the closing transaction is subject to the approval of the County Attorney, and the transaction is further subject to pre-audit in the manner required by the Local Government Budget and Fiscal Control Act by the Finance Director.
- 3. That this resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.

**Subject:** Creswell request for truck payment 2024-25

At last night's (August 26, 2024) Fire Commission meeting, Chief Ambrose of the Creswell Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. presented a request for payment from the additional budget award of 1 (one) penny property tax allocation for apparatus payments in the amount of \$18,350.70. This will meet the payment for calendar year 2024 on their 2005 International truck financed with Civic Federal Credit Union account number 4122587. A copy of this request and proof of debt statement is attached.

Based on a motion by Chief Josh Swain of Plymouth to recommend the payment of \$18,350.70 to Creswell Volunteer Fire Department for payment on the 2005 International truck; seconded by Chief John Spruill of Roper, Chair Ambrose called for a vote. The vote was unanimous in favor of the motion

**WHEREAS**, Washington County's Board of Commissioners had indicated its desire to assist in development efforts with Washington County; and,

**WHEREAS**, the full Board of Commissioners fully supports the proposed project by Washington County Courthouse Elevator Modernization which will result in the upgrade and modernization of the public elevator at the Washington County Courthouse at 120 Adams Street, Plymouth, NC, 27962; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners wished to pursue a formal application for the Rural Downtown Economic Development Grant in the amount of \$468,209.00 from the North Carolina Department of Commerce, Main Street & Rural Planning Center; and,
